Smt. Krishna Pathak Memorial Nineteenth Inter-School Painting and Craft Competition

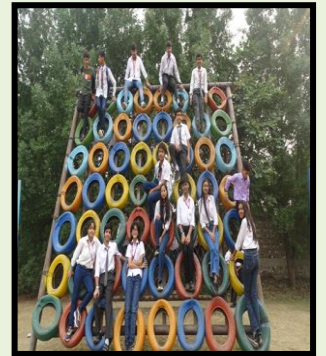

VISIT TO ROTI BANK

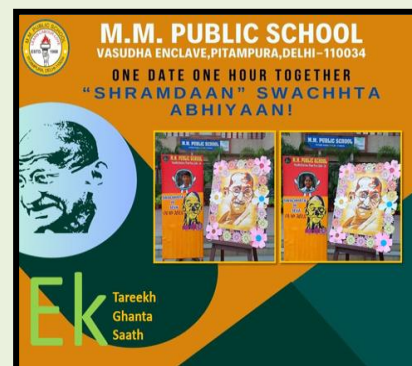

Shramdaan maha daan

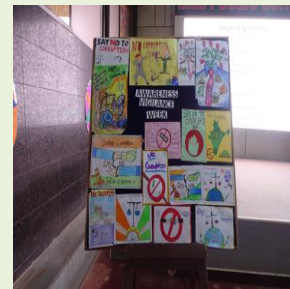

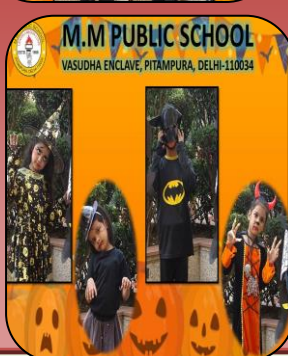
